TO BRYN MAWR HOSPITAL

BRYN MAWR - The Board of Directors of the Devon Horse Show and Country Fair made their annual contribution to Bryn Mawr Hospital at a reception held at the hospital on Friday, December 3, 2010. The donation will be used to finance the Comprehensive Breast Cancer Center expansion, purchase a Kubtec Xray cabinet for breast cancer surgery and sponsor educational packets for breast cancer patients.

"The Devon Horse Show and Bryn Mawr Hospital have been so closely linked to improving the care of our community for so many years that to be named as a recipient for this year is truly a great honor," says Thomas G. Frazier, MD, medical director of the Comprehensive Breast Center.
