HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:

The State of Pennsylvania requires that all horses must be in possession of a current negative Coggins certificate (EIA) dated within the previous 12 months. The Devon Horse Show and Country Fair will not accept or process any animal whose negative Coggins certificate, or copy thereof (issued after September 13, 2022) does not accompany the horse. The show may retain a copy for its records. **US Equestrian Equine Vaccination Rule GR845 will also be enforced**. Go to Devon Fall Classic's website to download the Biosecurity Form, which can be used to document vaccinations as per the US Equestrian rule.

Stalls are in permanent barns, and are approximately 10' X 10' with doors.

STALL FEES (No Stall Splits):

Full show week stall - \$250.00

Available starting 8:00 a.m. Wednesday, September 13th through the conclusion of the horse show on Sunday, September 17th. Any early arrival or layover stabling must be arranged in advance.

SHIP IN FEE (showing from the trailer/van) - \$100.00

SPORTMANSHIP: Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the Judges or Officials on the part of any owner, rider, driver, trainer or groom may disqualify the horse, and the owner will forfeit all entry and other fees. The Committee reserves the right to prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse and to remove any horse, owner, rider or groom from the Show without being liable for compensation. The Committee will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to any rider, driver, trainer, groom or attendant, animal, carriage or equipment at the Show. Should any questions arise that are not provided for in the rules, the same will be referred to the Show Committee whose decision will be final.

WELFARE: Upholding the welfare of the horses being exhibited in the Devon Fall Classic is of prmary concern to the Devon Fall Classic Committee. We require that all horses be treated with the kindness, respect and compassion they deserve and should never be subjected to mistreatment. Exhibitors, owners, trainers, grooms, or their agents must use reasonable care in the handling and treatment of the horses owned by them or placed in their care for competition or any other purpose. We will provide continuous well-being of the horse by vigorously enforcing the rules of US Equestrian which pertain to the welfare of the horse. Exhibitors are cautioned that Article 830 and HU102 will be narrowly interpreted. Violators will be automatically penalized by the elimination of the horse involved from the class in which it is participating and the next succeeding class in which it is entered. All such violations will be recorded in the US Equestrian Stewart's Report and be reviewed by the Hearing Committee for such action as may be deemed appropriate.

ENTRIES:

- For Children's and adult sections <u>only</u>, cross entry is permitted from High and Low classes offered on the same day and throughout the section, with the exception of Classics.
- Entries and stall reservations close Tuesday, September 5th, 2023 at 5:00 PM. Post entries will be accepted at \$50.00 per horse.

HOW TO GET TO DEVON

Street Address: 23 Dorset Road, Devon, PA 19333

By automobile or van:

From Pennsylvania Turnpike heading east or west or Northeast Extension heading south: Take I-476S to Exit 13, Route 30W to Devon Show Grounds on left.

From Delaware, Maryland and points south: I-95N to I-476N to Route 30W to Devon Show Grounds on left.

By train - Paoli/Thorndale Regional Rail Line:

From 30th Street Station in Philadelphia or Suburban Station in downtown Philadelphia at 16th and John F. Kennedy Boulevard: the Paoli Thorndale Regional Rail trains run about every 35 minutes to Devon and return. Nationwide rail connections from 30th Street Station. The show grounds are an easy walk over, just one block away.

By air:

From Philadelphia International Airport visitors can take the SEPTA Airport Train to 30th Street Railroad Station, and take R5 Paoli/Thorndale Regional Rail Line train to Devon Station (see above).

FEES: Checks, credit cards and cash will be accepted. Please enclose check or completed credit card form as payment with entry. Payment of all fees must be made in US Funds. Make checks payable to : Devon Fall Classic. A penalty of \$50.00 will be charged for all non-negotiable funds. Management reserves the right to prohibit from competition and return the entry of any owner, rider, driver or trainer whose processing or entry fee payment has been returned as non-negotiable on one or more occassions. The horse show reserves the right to require guaranteed funds from exhibitors. All financial matters regarding the 2023 Devon Fall Classic will be closed by October 19, 2023, NSF collection excepted. When you provide a check as payment, you authorize us either to use the information from your check to make a one-time electronic fund transfer from your account or to process the payment as a check transaction. All entries will be charged a **\$60.00 office fee and a \$50 Medic/Security fee**.

TIME SCHEDULE: The time schedule and order of events herein is tentative. Exhibitors are responsible for having entries at the ring 30 minutes before class time. No class will be delayed more than 3 minutes. Exhibitors must request the Starter to adjust for conflicts.

STARTING ORDER: Starting orders will be established for every class over fences. A systematic rotation will be employed within each section.

SCHOOLING: Daily schooling schedules will be posted and available at the show office. *NO LUNGING OF HORSES WILL BE PERMITTED ANYWHERE ON THE SHOWGROUNDS WHILE THE SHOW IS IN SESSION. NO EXCEPTIONS.*

ATTIRE: Proper show attire, including jacket, is required for all classes on Friday evening, Saturday evening, and all classes on Sunday.

SCRATCHES: Stabling and office fees are non-refundable after the closing date of entries. If a horse has shown in any class it is not eligible for a refund. Horses entered may be scratched without a veterinarian's certificate by notifying the Show Office in writing by Monday, September 4, 2023 and entry fees will be refunded less a \$60.00 processing fee. Should a horse be deemed unable to compete after Monday, September 4, 2023 a scratch submitted with a veterinarian's certificate will be eligible for a refund of entry fees less a \$60.00 processing fee. No other scratches will be permitted. Refunds will be mailed within 30 days after completion of the show.

PRIZE MONEY: All prize money will be paid through the Show Office. All prize monies will be mailed within 30 days after the completion of the show to the owner of record or an alternate payee listed on the entry blank. An exhibitor must furnish a Social Security number or Federal Tax ID number or be subject to IRS withholding of 30%. Exhibitors that are from a different country must provide an ITIN (International Tax Payer ID) or be subject to a 30% IRS withholding fee. The exhibitor is responsible for providing valid tax information and a valid mailing address to the show, and prize money cannot and will not be distributed until ALL of this information is supplied to the horse show office. Prize money is paid to owner as listed on the entry blank unless Alternate Payee section is completed in full. There is a \$25 charge to reissue prize money check if exhibitor fails to provide complete and current accurate information to show office.

PARKING: Daily parking for ship-ins is extremely limited and will be on a first come first served basis. Please expedite unloading/loading of horses and equipment. **SHIP IN FEE \$100**.

CAMPERS: No Campers or RV's allowed on the grounds or in the parking lots.

DOGS: Dogs will not be permitted on the premises unless restrained on a leash. Stable dogs must be confined at all times. Any owner of a dog found loose on the show grounds will be fined \$100 and will be responsible for the entry fees of the horse(s) whose performance may be disrupted.

BIOHAZARDOUS MEDICAL WASTE: Containers will be provided in the Stable Area. All exhibitors and their agents are responsible for the proper disposal of medical waste.

WATER HOSES: All water hoses MUST have a cutoff valve or an on/off nozzle on the outflow end. No hose is to be left unattended. Water conservation is of the utmost importance.

JUMPER DIVISION

AWARDS: Prize money and twelve ribbons in all stake and championship classes. All other classes prize money and eight ribbons.

NOMINATING FEE: To be eligible for the Jumper Division (except Take 2 Thoroughbred Young Jumpers) horses must be nominated and the nominating fee of \$150 paid by the closing date of entries. Horses nominated after that date must pay a nominating fee of \$200. Once a horse is nominated he becomes entitled to compete in any jumper class for which he is eligible, upon payment of the showing fee for said class.

DECLARATIONS: Declarations are due in the horse show office by 4:00pm the day preceding all Jumper classes unless otherwise noted. Unless otherwise stated, declarations made after the above stated time will be accepted up to 30 minutes before the start of the class and a late fee of \$10 per class will be assessed.

COURSES: Courses may consist of any combination of the following: Brush, gates, oxers, posts and rails, water, Liverpool, walls, panels, and coops.

MARTINGALES: Classes offered at 1.30m or below have no martingale restrictions when used in a conventional manner. Classes offered above 1.30m (and all classes restricted to young horses) - the only martingales permitted are running martingales used in the conventional manner.

TIME ALLOWED: The Time Allowed will be calculated at 350 meters per minute. Unless otherwise specified, horse/ponies tied for other than first place will be placed on their time in the first round.

All Jumper Classics must have at least 8 entries or they will be sweepstakes classes.

US EQUESTRIAN MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules). Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

US EQUESTRIAN MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
